On Friday 11th February 2022 from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the place of sports centre. In case of late come, the competitors are not guaranteed to be registered for the competition. The coach must attend registration and the weighing.

On Saturday 12th February 2022 from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. there will be an **extra junior weighing** for the Sunday's competition. There will be no possibility to change the category!

Discipline MATSOGI (sparring)

Discipline is for competitors with 2. gup and higher. (T.D. 4. and 3. gup may start under the condition accepting the mentioned rules.)

„compulsory spin kick“ will be applied for all technical degrees for age group younger/older junior male/female and adult male/female.

Safety equipment

- Each competitor must have head and shin protector
- The female competitors (jun. + adult) must wear a breast protector inside her dobok shirt
- Allowed protectors for competitors follow the list of approved protectors for competitions organized by the Czech Taekwon-Do Federation ITF
- Hand, feet and **head** protectors must be of **red** or **blue** color
- Each competitor (except youth) must have a 10 oz gloves
- 10 oz protectors for youth are NOT allowed
- „Old design“ doboks are not allowed
- Open gloves are not allowed

System of competition

The system of competition for sparring will be for all **junior and adult groups everyone with everyone** (league/groups). In case, there are 6 and more competitors in one category, they will be divided into more groups. The match in groups and finals will be of 2 rounds. The match in groups **may end in draw** and each competitor will receive **1 point**. Winner receives 2 points. There will only **one third place**, competitors will fight for it.

All **youth groups** compete only in pyramid **elimination** system (from the first round to the final).

Discipline TUKGI (special techniques)

Discipline is for competitors with 6. gup and higher. Competitors with 6. to 4. gup can compete only with techniques nopi, dollyo a nomo. Each club can nominate a maximum of 2 competitors in each category. **A nomination technique will be used according to competitor's choice and will be announced by coach in online registration.**

For younger youth male and female will be used a foam stuck to the board for a greater safety of the competitors for dollyo and nopi techniques. The nomo chagi technique is kicked to the **target scoring 3 p. or 0 p.** Scoring for younger youth is **3 points for fully or partially deflected board and 1 point for a touch** (technically correct strike).

Discipline WIRYOK (power breaking)

Discipline is for competitors with 6. gup and higher. Competitors with 6. to 4. gup can compete only with techniques ap joomuk, sonkal, balkal, bal ap kumchi. Each club can nominate a maximum of 2 competitors in each category. **A nomination technique will be used according to competitor's choice and will be announced by coach in online registration.**

IV. Rules

The competition will be conducted according to the EITF rules, competition Directive No. 10 of the Czech Taekwon-Do Federation ITF and this Infopack.

V. Protest

Protest against umpire's decision can submit only coach and must be done with a valid procedure (announce **immediately** after the match and delivered to the appropriate ring on the form no later than 5 minutes after receiving the form), with a deposit of **50 EUR** to the chairman of the jury. Subsequently, the protest will be discussed and resolved by the Umpire Committee. The decision of committee is final.

VI. Referees

The registration of referees for the competition is done through **online portal of members** with the knowledge of club. The total number of referees for this competition is 46. Umpire committee consists of 3 members.

Meal will be arranged for **all** registered referees during a whole day of their judging. The referees who competes one day can ask in an application for a dinner for free for a day before they judge (Friday/Saturday).

Accommodation is arranged and paid by Czech Taekwondo Federation ITF to all invited referees who ask for it in online application for referees. The referees will be accommodated in hotel closest to the sports hall. Referees can also arrange accommodation alone together with their club. During registration, the referee will be paid an accommodation costs corresponding to the hotel's costs for the referees. Approved judges, who will one day judge and compete the second day, will be covered for 1 day of accommodation and meals (plus additional dinner). If they are interested, they can stay on both days with their club (they will receive a contribution for 1 night) or use accommodation from the Czech Taekwondo Federation ITF for both days (they will pay 1 night).

Referees obligations. Referees have to be dressed by official ITF (incorrect dress code could be penalized with a fine of 10 EUR/day/item) rules and have to be available in sport hall according to the commands of the head referee and be able to arbitrate. Competitors may arbitrate as well in days when there is no listed their age category. Failure to comply with the above may result in a reduction or not paying the arbitration reward.

VII. Number of competitors

The number of competitors nominated by club is not limited. In special techniques and power breaking can each club nominate at maximum 2 competitors for each category.

VIII. Trophies

Competitors placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded medals. The most successful competitors from each category will be awarded a trophy, as well as the most successful club of Czech OPEN 2022.

IX. Remaining

Registration and payments

Accommodation and meal for **registered and confirmed referees** is automatically ordered and paid by Czech Taekwondo Federation ITF (if the referee does not reject it in registration, one day referees follow VI. of this propositions)

Registration consists of:

- a) Check of application
- b) Check of health inspections
- c) Pay of starting fee
- d) Pay of accommodation and meal
- e) refunds / referees payment, whose are concerned (follow VI. of this propositions)
- f) weighing all competitors of all weight categories for matsogi (independent on other actions)

The payment is possible in cash or by credit card.

Change in starting list

Every change in starting list (e.g. incorrect categorization of competitor etc.) after a **coach meeting** is charged with 50,- EUR.

Doping

The head coach guarantee that each competitor of his is familiar with the content of directive no. 14 (Guidelines for the fight against doping within the system of all competitions of the Czech Taekwon-do Federation ITF).

X. Accomodation

Accommodation and meal is order for you by competition department of our federation. Fill in the form for accommodation and meal and you will be given one of booked hotels in Nymburk and its surroundings and provided ordered meal. The B&B accommodation costs **28 EUR/person/night**. The price of **one** meal is (lunch, dinner) **8 EUR per person**.

Those who stays in SC Nymburk will pay extra fee for disinfection: **5 EUR/person/stay** and fee for the city Nymburk in all accommodation facilities: **1 EUR/ person** older 18/night. All will be paid at the registration. In case of not occupy the announced number of accommodation and meal, you will be charged 100% storno fee.

In case that subject will not fill it in online application form, they will not be provided with accommodation and food.
